## UN Assembly Chief meets His Majesty

The current president of the United Nations General Assembly visited Oman this week and held talks with His Majesty the Sultan.

Mr Salim Ahmed al Salim is Tanzania's permanent representative at the U.N., will remain in office as assembly president until September. He was the presiding officer of the recent debate on the Russian invasion of Afghanistan.

He said he discussed "the present international situation" with His Majesty.
